Councilmember Garver moved to open the special meeting at 7:00 p.m. and Councilmember Standiferd seconded. Motion passed unanimously, 4-0.


3. Call to Public – None at this time

A Resolution of the City of Basehor, Kansas Declaring the Necessity of the City of Basehor, Kansas, A Municipal Corporation, to Appropriate through the Exercise of Eminent Domain Certain Interests in Real Property for the use of Said City Pursuant to K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 26-501 Et Seq., and Granting Authorization to Obtain a Survey and Description of the Land or Interests to be Condemned, All in Accordance with K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 26-201 – Resolution 2023-01

Councilmember Garver moved that city council adopt a resolution of the City of Basehor, Kansas declaring the necessity of the City of Basehor, Kansas, A municipal corporation, to appropriate through the exercise of eminent domain certain interests in real property for the use of said city pursuant to K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 26-501 Et Seq., and granting authorization to obtain a survey and description of the Land or interests to be condemned, all in accordance with K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 26-201 – Resolution 2023-01 and authorized the Mayor to sign such resolution and Councilmember Sims seconded. Motion passed, 3-1 with Councilmember Maples voting no.
