Alive At 25

Driving class option for ages 15-18

The Basehor Municipal Court offers a one-time option for defendants aged 15-18 to keep a minor traffic violation off their record by completing an online driving class and paying a reduced fee. **Please note that any speed over 25 mph will be court required.**

Prior to the scheduled court appearance, the defendant will pay the cost and attend a four-hour online driving class through Alive At 25. At the completion of the course, you will print the certificate of completion.

The Defendant will also print off the Diversion Agreement, read and sign the agreement, along with a parent/guardian.

The agreement, certificate and the reduced fee of \$65.00 (money order only) will be either mailed or delivered in person to the court. If all requirements are met, no appearance will be required.

At the end of the 90-day diversion, the court shall run the defendants driving record.

- If there is no record during the diversion period, the violation will be dismissed.
- Should a record be found, the court will notify the Defendant and Parent/Guardian of the findings and notice of revocation hearing will be set within 60 days.

Prior to taking the course, contact the court to ensure your child is eligible for this program.
