

ORDINANCE NO. 569

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XIV OF THE CITY CODE TO INCLUDE NEW ARTICLE 4 PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES WITHIN THE CITY

WHEREAS, the Governing Body recognizes there are certain streets within the City that are difficult to clear snow from due to their narrowness and large number of vehicles that are regularly parked on the streets; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body believes it is necessary to impose emergency snow routes to facilitate the clearing of all streets within the City of snow, to ensure the flow of traffic after snow storms, and to protect the health and safety of persons using the streets.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Basehor:

Section 1. The Governing Body hereby amends Chapter XIV of the City Code to include new Article 4 which shall read as follows:

ARTICLE 4: EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES

- 14-401. **TRAFFIC EMERGENCY.** (a) Whenever snow has accumulated in the amount of two inches or greater, a traffic emergency will be deemed to have occurred and will remain in effect until snowing has ceased and city streets have been cleared of snow. Until such traffic emergency is terminated, it shall be unlawful to:
- (1) Park a vehicle on any street designated an emergency snow route in section 14-404;
 - (2) Operate a motor vehicle on any emergency snow route in such manner or condition that such motor vehicle stalls and is unable to proceed by reason of the fact that the driving wheels are not equipped with tire chains or snow tires.
- (b) The Mayor, during a traffic emergency, is empowered to waive or suspend enforcement of parking regulations not specifically designated within this article.
- 14-402. **NOTICE.** All streets designated as an emergency snow route shall be conspicuously posted with signs notifying the public of when parking on such streets is prohibited.
- 14-403. **REMOVAL OF VEHICLES.** All vehicles parked on emergency snow routes must be removed upon the accumulation of two inches or greater of snow on the street, and shall remain off of the route until the snow has ceased and has been cleared from the route by city crews. Any vehicle parked on an emergency snow route after such period of time may be removed or caused to be removed by the city

to the nearest garage or other place of safety and the vehicle may not be recovered until the towing and storage charges are paid.

14-404. ESTABLISHMENT OF ROUTES; POSTING OF SIGNS. (a) The following streets are hereby established as emergency snow routes within the city:

- (1) 155th and Donahoo south to Pine Ridge.
- (2) Pine Ridge west to 158th St.
- (3) 142nd and Parallel west to 163rd and Parallel.
- (4) 151st and Leavenworth Rd. west to 158th and Leavenworth Rd.
- (5) Club House Dr. south to Falcon Lakes Dr.
- (6) 147th and Falcon Lakes Dr. east to K-7.
- (7) 142nd and Falcon Lakes Dr. to 141st St.
- (8) 141st and Falcon Lakes Dr. to Donahoo
- (9) 152nd Ct. west to 155th Terr
- (10) 155th Terr. south to Klamm west to 157th St. south to Leavenworth Rd.
- (11) 155th and Pin Oak east to 154th St.
- (12) 154th and Poplar west to 157th Terr.
- (13) 158th and Hickory east to 154th Terr.
- (14) 155th and Basehor Blvd. east to grade school.
- (15) 155th and Crestwood west and back to 155th St.
- (16) 155th and Elm east to 153rd St. south to Parallel.
- (17) 145th and Parallel Ln. west to 147th St. then south to Parallel.
- (18) 142nd and Parallel south to 24/40
- (19) 150th and Parallel south to 24/40
- (20) 150th and Craig west to 151st Terr. south to Josh east to 150th St.
- (21) 150th and Chestnut west to 155th St.
- (22) 152nd and Parallel south to Chestnut.
- (23) 155th and Wolf Creek Pkwy east to 150th St.
- (24) 156th and Parallel south to Landauer west to 157th St north to Parallel
- (25) 158th and Parallel south to 24/40
- (26) 158th and Garden Pkwy west to 159th St.
- (27) 159th and Parallel south to Prairie Way.
- (28) 159th and Cedar St. west to Garden Pkwy west to 161st St. north to Parallel
- (29) 166th and Coralberry Crossing west to Hidden Ridge east on Ruby Way.
- (30) 166th and Pinehurst Dr. west to 169th St. south to Juniper Dr.
- (31) 169th and Sheehan east to Pinehurst Dr.
- (32) 158th and Pinehurst east to 155th St.
- (33) 158th and Cedar Ln east to 153rd St. north to Bradford Ct.
- (34) Bradford Ct. east to Pine Ridge west to 153rd St.

(b) The city public works director shall cause appropriate signs to be installed along each of the streets designated emergency snow routes under subsection (a).

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council, approval by the Mayor and publication in the City's official newspaper.

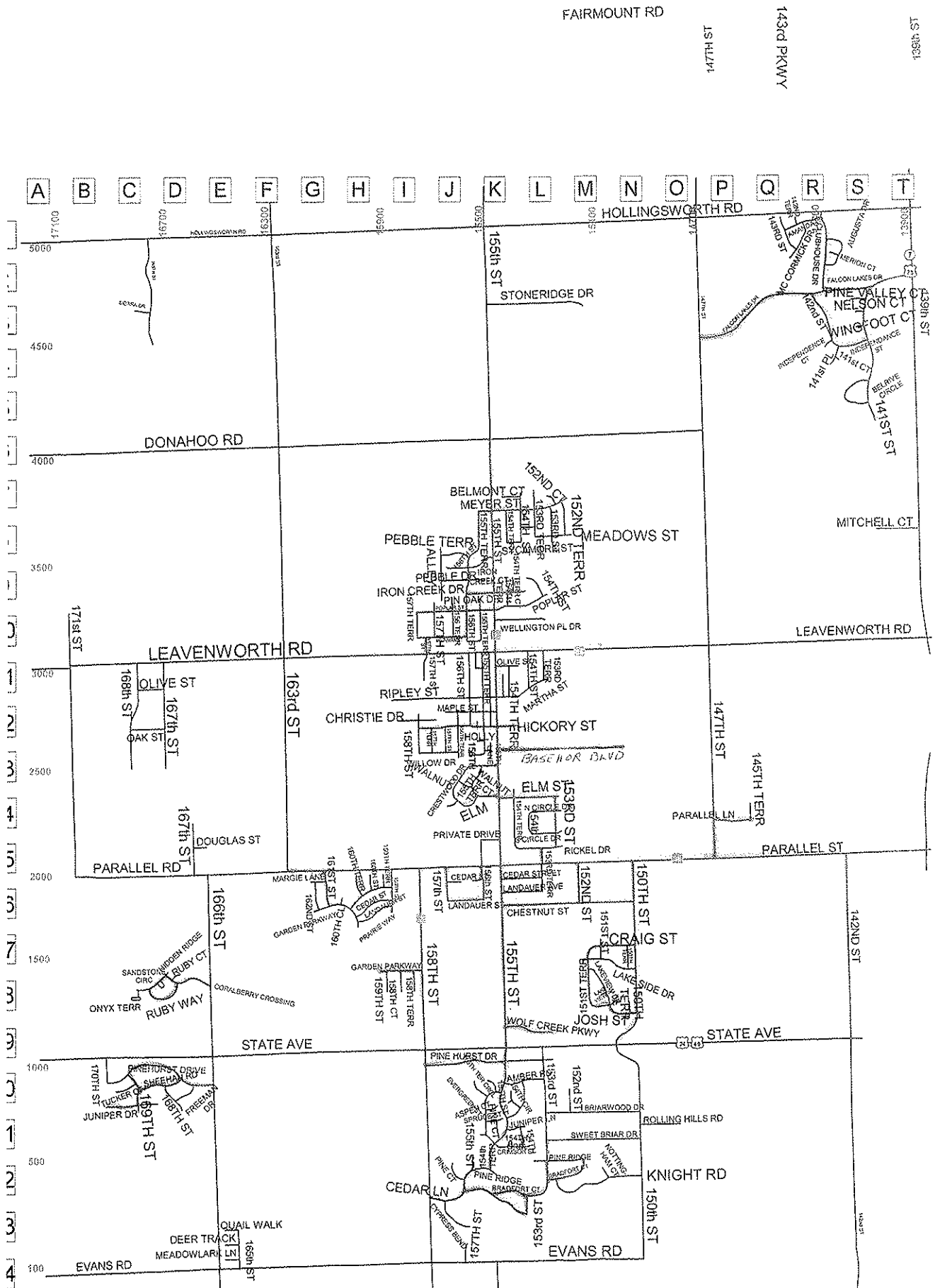

CITY OF BASEHOR
